SCHOLARSHIP—PROCEDURES AND REQUIREMENTS

- A. This scholarship is to be given to a White River Valley School graduate or graduating senior. The recipient must be attending a junior college, technical school, approved trade school, or a four-year institution.
- B. This is to be an award of one five hundred-dollar (\$500.00) scholarship, for one year, with the recipient being allowed to apply for the award the following year if the scholarship is being offered.
- C. The check will be made out to the recipients, upon presentation of class schedule to the Lions Club.
- D. All the following information <u>MUST</u> be included for full consideration:
 - 1. Scholarship application
 - 2. Proof of acceptance to the school of the applicant choice
 - 3. Transcript of grades
 - 4. S.A.T. Scores (H.S. Graduating seniors only)
 - 5. Class Ranking (H.S. Graduating seniors only)
 - 6. Record of attendance
 - 7. A letter of recommendation from at least one of the following: teacher, instructor, counselor, staff member or coach.
 - 8. WORK: If you have worked or are currently working, a letter of recommendation must come from your employer with information to include length of employment and hours you work per week.
