To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Have a 3.5 GPA or better for high school applicants.
- B) Have financial need as determined by a completed FAFSA form

1) Nature-Saving Scholarships - \$1,000 - 2 Awards (Deadline: March 11, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be currently enrolled in high school, university, or college.
- B) Create an original list of nature-saving rules.

2) BMW Engineering Scholarship - \$6,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: March 15, 2018)
