**VOCABULARY** - Words 16 - 20 have been added this week. It is our hope that you are reading the words and discussing them with your students. These vocabulary words should now be posted in all classrooms at WRV.

1. **Abstract** - existing in thought or as an idea but not having a physical or concrete existence, a summary of the contents of a book, article, or formal speech, consider (something) theoretically or separately from something else
2. **Aerobic** - relating to, involving, or requiring free oxygen
3. **Analyze** - examine methodically and in detail the constitution or structure of, discover or reveal (something) through detailed examination
4. **Argumentative** - given to expressing divergent or opposite views, characterized by systematic reasoning
5. **Bio** - a biography or short biographical profile of someone, relating to life.
6. **Cardiovascular** - relating to the heart and blood vessels
7. **Central idea** - central, unifying element of the story, which ties together all of the other elements of fiction used by the author to tell the story
8. **Cite** - quote (a passage, book, or author) as evidence for or justification of an argument or statement, especially in a scholarly work.
9. **Coefficient** - a numerical or constant quantity placed before and multiplying the variable in an algebraic expression or a multiplier or factor that measures some property.
10. **Cohort** - a group of people banded together or treated as a group.
11. **Comparative (compare)** - perceptible by comparison
12. **Composition**- the way in which a whole or mixture is made up, the action of putting things together; formation or construction, a compound artificial substance, the successive application of functions to a variable, a work of music, literature, or art.
13. **Conservative** - holding to traditional attitudes and values.
14. **Contrast**- the state of being strikingly different from something else, compare in such a way as to emphasize differences.
15. **Cross-hatching**- (in drawing or graphics) shade (an area) with intersecting sets of parallel lines.
